



Two-woman



Meyers Taylor/Hoffman Win Bronze

After winning silver in the Olympic debut of women's monobob at the Beijing (China) Winter Games, Elana Meyers Taylor became the most decorated Olympic U.S. bobsledder on February 19, 2022, with a bronze medal in the two-woman event, bringing her total to five. The 37-year-old pilot paired with brakewoman Sylvia Hoffman. Clocking in at 4:05.48, the duo finished behind only two German bobsleds. Meyers Taylor is the first U.S. Winter Olympian to enter five events and win a medal in all of them after taking two-woman silver in Pyeongchang and Sochi and bronze in Vancouver. That's more than any Black athlete in Winter Olympic history, the most by any women's bobsledder at the Olympics, and two more than any other Olympic bobsledder, male or female, has won for the United States. Meyers Taylor also broke her own record for oldest American women to medal at the Winter Olympics by five days. And, thanks to women having two events at the Olympics for the first time this year, she's going to forever be the first female bobsledder to win two medals at the same Games. Sylvia Hoffman (b. 1989) won her first Olympic medal in her debut after taking up bobsled as a result of the NBC reality show/training camp *Next Olympic Hopeful*. Hoffman did not win the program but still was invited by the U.S. Bobsled team to attend the rookie training camp. With the team, she competed in the 2018-2019 World Cup competition at Innsbruck, Austria; she received bronze with partner Elana Meyers Taylor. In 2020, Hoffman, with partner Kaillie Humphries, won the World Cup at Königssee, Germany.

Clocking in at 4:05.48, the duo finished behind only two German bobsleds.

Erin Jackson Wins Gold

Erin Jackson (b. September 19, 1992) began inline skating when she was 10 years old and spent 15 years piling up titles and traveling the world. At the 2018 Pyeongchang (South Korea) Winter Olympics, she became the first Black woman to qualify for a U. S. Olympic long track speed skating spot. And although she finished in 24th-place in the women's 500 meters at the Gangneung Oval, Jackson was considered a star in the making and the future of U. S. long track speed skating. Four years later, the 29-year-old former inline speed skater arrived at the Beijing (China) Winter Olympics as the top-ranked ice speed skater in the world in the 500, and on February 13, 2022, she won gold in the women's 500 meters at the National Speed Skating Oval with a time of 37.04, earning her first Olympic medal in what historically has been her best event. Jackson is the first U.S. woman to win a speed skating gold at the Olympics since Bonnie Blair did so in 1994, as well as being the first Black American woman to win gold in an individual sport at the Winter Olympics. For Jackson, the move to ice did not come until just five years ago, after she graduated from the University of Florida with a degree in Materials Science & Engineering.






